

PREPARATION PHASE: 2013

- Recruit key families and individuals to move to Denver
- Develop partnerships with individuals, churches and networks in Denver
- Develop prospectus and other documents
- Develop administrative support and accountability systems
- Secure support structures: church and network partnerships, prayer team, financial support team
- Determine strategic locations for team members to live
- Sell house and other possessions
- Move families to Denver

PRE-LAUNCH PHASE: JANUARY-AUGUST 2014

- Recruit and Develop Launch Team
- Recruit, Build & Cultivate relationships with partners
- Visit various churches to learn
- Engage community by servant evangelism, participating in community planned events, building relationships and conducting surveys
- Build relationships with various leaders in the community (i.e. mayor, school officials, other church leaders)
- Establish web, social media and community presence
- Develop internship to develop leaders and invest in church leaders
- Begin seeker groups in various locations
- Secure meeting location
- Develop strategic processes for preview services and launch day
- Buy necessary equipment
- Plan and conduct preview services (May, June, July & August)
- Celebrate preview services

LAUNCH PHASE: SEPTEMBER 2014

- Continue to develop and grow launch team
- Develop and implement community-wide marketing strategy
- Recruit and Develop strategic leaders and volunteers for various areas (guest services, assimilation, childrens, music)
- Mobilize mission teams to assist the church
- Begin weekly worship on September 21st
- Celebrate launch day with team
- Communicate and celebrate with partners
